TENNESSEE SECTION ITE

The Tennessee Division of the Institute of Transportation Engineers (TDITE) was officially constituted and recognized as a Division under the Southern Section ITE in 1966. The original constitution and by-laws were developed and signed by twenty founding members on February 18, 1966.

Many Tennessee Division members have been active at the regional and national levels. Marble Hensley, served as President of the Institute of Transportation Engineers in 1969 and has a Southern Section/District award named in his honor. Past Presidents of the Southern Section/District include Marble Hensley, Earl Williams, Jack Marcellis, Charles Miller, James Yarbrough, Edward Watt and Dr. Robert Stammer, Jr.

The Tennessee Division underwent a change in status in the late 1980's. To correspond with the upgrade of the Southern Section ITE to a District, Glenn Beckwith, TDITE President, submitted a formal request for Section status for the Tennessee Division on August 12, 1987. In June 1988, the Tennessee Division ITE ceased to exist and the Division was upgraded to the Tennessee Section ITE (TSITE).

By the end of the Tennessee Division in 1988, membership had grown from the original twenty members to 119 members. Today membership stands over 250.
